SUBJECT: COVID-19 Public Health Risk Categories

1. The following categories, status, and status definitions will be used for all Team Patrick personnel for accountability and tracking during COVID-19 Response. This includes military members, civilian employees, dependents, retirees, contractors, and any persons on the installation for any reason.

| Category | Status | Definition |
|-------------------------------------|--------------|---|
| COVID-19 Positive | Isolated | A person who has been tested by a medical professional and confirmed positive for COVID- 19. |
| PUI (Person Under Investigation) | Isolated | A <i>symptomatic</i> (fever, coughing, and/or shortness of breath) person who is either awaiting testing or test results from a medical professional for COVID-19. |
| Close Contact/ Travelers | Quarantined | An <i>asymptomatic</i> person who was potentially exposed either through travel or as a close contact with a "COVID-19 Positive" or "PUI." |
| 24 to 72-Hour Hold | Observation | A <i>symptomatic</i> person who does not meet criteria for COVID-19 testing and may return to duty when symptoms have resolved, unless directed otherwise by medical personnel. |
| Returned to Duty | Reintegrated | A person who was returned to duty (or recovered) by a medical professional from Isolated, Quarantined, or Observation Status. |
| | | As of 20 March 2020: If you test positive for COVID-19 you are to remain home 3 days after your symptoms subside and this must be at least 7 days after the onset of symptoms. You must also be cleared by a medical professional. |

2. Commanders or their designated representative, may call the 45th Medical Group at 321-494-8100 to coordinate with the Public Health Emergency Officer (PHEO), who will determine the appropriate disposition (Observation, Quarantine, Isolate, or Reintegrate).
