CONDUCT & LIABILITY

Patrick Air Force Base and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station are secure installations and all media agree to abide by 45th Space Wing safety and security rules. Violation of these rules and regulations may result in the immediate suspension or revocation of credentials.

INITIAL

Media must be escorted at all times while on Patrick Air Force Base and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station.

Media under the escort of Launch Provider Public Affairs must abide by the instructions and conduct set forth for launch viewing.

Unprofessional activities will not be tolerated. Unprofessional activities include:

- Any behavior deemed disruptive to assigned base escorts, other media members, base operations, or space program and facility personnel
- Seeking autographs
- Peddling materials for profit
- Collecting government-provided materials (photographs and other written products) for purposes other than publication or background research
- Any behavior deemed unlawful
- The possession of alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs, or firearms while on base

All media and any property in their possession or control are subject to any search or detention necessary for the protection of information and property.

Smoking is not permitted on the ITL Causeway or at other media launch viewing sites on CCAFS, in any base facility, at or near any launch complex, or in any government vehicle.

Violators of these rules will be removed from the installation IMMEDIATELY and have their media credentials to cover future missions revoked. By submitting this application for accreditation, I have agreed to abide by all the 45th Space Wing safety and security rules for Patrick Air Force Base and Cape Canaveral Air Force Station.
