The Medical Group has a supply of COVID At-Home Test Kits for ID card holders and we will distribute these test kits every **Tuesday** and **Thursday, 0800-1500** from the **Public Health Clinic**. Those desiring to receive an at-home test must present their military Common Access Card or dependent/retiree ID card. Parents/sponsors may receive test kits on behalf of their dependents upon presenting the dependent's military ID card. The technician will verify the number of dependents on record for children too young to have an ID card. When coming to collect your at-home tests, check in at a kiosk and select public health. You will then be helped in the order you checked in.
